PA turnpike to New Exit 242 (Old Exit 18), I-83 north to New Exit 43 (Old Exit 23), 2nd St, Left on Market, go across bridge to City Island and follow tournament signs.

Trophies for 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th Places
 (All competitors ages 10 & under, who do not place in the top 4, will receive medals)

The promoter reserves the right to divide or combine divisions based upon the number, age, sex, or rank of the competitors.

*FIGHTING – Under Belt fighting will be 2 minutes, 3 points wins. (Black Belt fighting will be decided the day of each event) Foam-dipped hand, foot, head, shin, mouth, and groin protection mandatory. No targets below waist and no head contact, sweeps or leg checks. Kicks and punches each count one (1) point. There must be at least two (2) competitors for a fighting division to be run. Trophies will NOT be awarded in a fight division with only one (1) competitor.

FORMS – Musical and Soft Style Divisions will be added at Black Belt Level; only. (3 or more needed to create a division)

UNDER BLACK BELT RANKS - Beginner is for children ages 6 & Under with less than six months experience. (White Belt; Only)
 Novice is generally a white/yellow/orange belt.
 Intermediate is generally a green/blue/purple belt.
 Advanced is generally a red/brown belt.

Handicapable Divisions will be created the day of the event as needed.
